
Grace Presbytery Looking for a Few Good Men (and Women)

This just in from Grace Presbytery: Have you considered serving Grace Presbytery? We have many opportunities for you!


Each year, Grace Presbytery has a limited number of openings for persons willing to serve as part of presbytery structures (committees and commissions).
